The François Baclesse Cancer Centre, is a private, non-profit cancer centre, located in Caen (Normandy, France). We belong to the Unicancer group (a network of 18 dedicated cancer centres across France), counting altogether more than 20,000 employees and treating more than half a million cancer patients a year. The Unicancer group is the largest promoter of academic clinical trials in oncology in Europe and 5th in the world by number of publications. <http://www.unicancer.fr/en>
As a comprehensive cancer centre, we provide care, research and training in the field of oncology. We employ around 1,084 staff, including 144 practitioners and researchers, Our institution counts 220 beds for hospitalization and welcome 7657 new patients per year.

The François Baclesse Cancer Centre is a leading national and international player in the field of cancer research with broad access to diagnostic and therapeutic innovation. In 2020, we were OECD (Comprehensive Cancer Centre) certified as well as EUSOMA certified for the treatment of breast cancer. We were also ranked among the top 100 hospitals specializing in oncology by the American magazine Newsweek and 1st French regional centre for the treatment of breast cancer by the magazine Le Point.

Caen is a dynamic city, offering a university, sports facilities and attractive housing. Caen is located 230 km from Paris (2 hours by train). It is a medium-size city (100,000 inhabitants) where life is good, close to the sea and the beaches (Cabourg, Deauville, Cotentin beaches, etc.) surrounded by rural countryside (Bocage Normand, Pays d'Auge...).

The François Baclesse Centre is looking for a radiologist for its diagnostic and therapeutic imaging department.

The imaging department has just been completely renovated. It comprises 3 units:

- diagnostic imaging which has:
2 CT-scans (including one dedicated in part to interventional radiology)
1 1.5 Tesla MRI with a plan for a 2nd MRI in 2022
1 conventional radiology table
2 ultrasound machines including 1 dedicated to cervical and thyroid ultrasound

- senology:
3 consultation rooms, 1 mammography machine and 1 macrobiopsy table

- interventional radiology:
1 dedicated room in the operating theater

1 dedicated CT-scan (biopsies, radiofrequency, cryotherapy, cementoplasty)

The radiologist will be part of a team of 6 radiologists and 1 senior resident, and will contribute to the department's activities by participating in particular in :

- diagnostic imaging (MRI, CT, ultrasound)
- senology and / or interventional radiology
- multidisciplinary tumour boards
- research projects in imaging and oncology.

He/She will provide an activity focused on oncological imaging. He/She will be the referent to one or two multidisciplinary tumour boards.

He/She will also have a supervisory role for junior and senior residents.

Any training will be possible for a radiological activity that is desired but not yet fully mastered.

He/She will be able to devote one day per week to research, development and teaching.

The Imaging department is part of the Medicotechnical Division with the Nuclear Medicine department (1 digital PET / CT, 3 gamma cameras, 4 rooms for vectorized internal radiotherapy) and the Radiotherapy department (7 radiotherapy devices including 2 tomotherapies and 1 cyberknife, a unit for brachytherapy) with access to the Cyclad proton therapy centre since 2018.

Working conditions:

- Salary according to the scale of the National Collective Agreement of Cancer Centers for the status of specialist practitioner. The salary will be back dated from the date of registration as a Radiologist.
- Support in finding accommodation
- Health insurance
- 6 weeks of paid vacation per year, and annual working time of 206 day (or 165 day for 80% of full time)
- Possible participation in the out of hours service.
